**Footnotes**

SAM'S GONE stalked a pair of duelers down the backstretch, asked mid turn and bid four wide at the quarter pole, raced abreast turning for home, drew off inside the eighth pole being kept to task. FITCHVILLE settled in the second flight, gained momentum leaving the quarter pole, split foes a sixteenth out traveling towards the inside, surged gamely securing second place in last jumps. SILVERSTRIKEYPRESS stumbled at the break, was quickly rushed up taking the lead, set the pace running in the two path, headed leaving the quarter pole, proved no match for the winner in the final furlong and faltered at the wire missing second place. CLEVER MISSILE pressed for the lead from the start, vied in a three way battle entering the stretch, angled a bit wider giving chase in upper stretch, lacked late kick just missing the show position. REMEMBER ME ADENA hustled down the backside, roused form the quarter pole, angled to the rail upper stretch, needed more late missing a minor award. BILLY SHIRTS raced evenly in mid pack, swung out six wide upper stretch, lacked surge besting rest. ECONOMY OF WORDS raced along the rail in the second flight, failed to respond when roused, never threatened. LOSE NO TIME was outrun shortly after the start, failed to factor. OUR FIRST AFFAIR raced wide down the backside, offered little. GOING STICK flashed brief foot tracking the pace along the rail, gave way past the quarter pole, no factor.
