TIME FOR GLORY hustled from the gate, out sprinted RELAUNCH QUEEN into the first turn for the lead, raced off the rail throughout, asked for more in upper stretch, responded to increase margin from mid stretch under a drive. RELAUNCH QUEEN showed good speed from the gate, was out sprinted for the lead by the winner, stalked on the turn, angled out top of the stretch, proved no match but was clearly second best in a game effort. TIZ SPANISH was hustled early, tracked racing off the rail, put to a drive near the 1/4 pole, lacked needed rally, bested rest. PETITE PERFECTION broke late, trailed to near the 1/4 pole, asked and rallied in upper stretch, moved in and out throughout the stretch run, finished strong in a willing effort. CHINCHILLA was sent hard from the start, stalked along the rail, remained under a drive from the 1/4 pole, had no late bid and tired in mid stretch. MINER'S MUSE came in at the start to bump J T'S SIN, hustled to race in mid pack, roused into the lane but had no late kick, finished evenly. SASSY SURPRISE ducked out at the break, rushed to track racing wide on the turn, had no bid and weakened from top of the lane. LADY C C brushed at the start, lacked speed, raced off the rail, never involved. J T'S SIN was pinched at the break, trailed throughout, proved no factor.
