SATIABLE was slow early, raced off the rail throughout, roused near the 1/4 pole, swung 7 wide in upper stretch, hit stride mid stretch, blew clear late to win going away. DINNER GHOST hustled and vied for the lead racing 3-4 wide and between rivals, held a head lead late but was no match nearing the wire, saved place position in a very game effort. UNBRIDLED MELODY sent hard, pressed and vied racing 4-5 wide on the turn, loomed in mid stretch, was out finished late, hard effort. ONE O THREE WEST stumbled at the start, hustled down the backside, put to a drive near the 1/4 pole, angled top of the lane, closed gap some in a willing effort. BELLA NOELLE sent hard, was involved in a four way duel and raced between foes throughout, started to tire in mid stretch. CREDITVILLE raced evenly in second flight, angled top of the lane, was under severe left handed stick but failed to mount rally. LOUVE SAUVAGE well placed early, tracked a four way speed duel, had to wait for room near the 1/4 pole, angled to the rail at the 3/16, asked from there, lacked rally and tired inside the eighth pole. JR.'S FREEDOM hustled and was involved in a four way duel early on, fought hard to top of the lane, gave way in upper stretch, used up. EASY LOOT was outrun early, dropped off mid turn, well beaten.
