Footnotes

YESSHESAROCKET showed good early foot, dueled inside of ROY'S TIME to the quarter pole, drew off mid stretch under little encouragement, was in hand coming to the wire. SOLO RUN raced evenly running mid track, asked near the quarter pole, angled over towards the rail mid stretch, found best stride and was closing strong at the wire. ROY'S TIME hustled from the gate, vied outside the winner to the quarter pole, proved no match from upper stretch, remained under a stiff drive, was out finished late losing the place position. CHIEF MENA raced evenly in mid pack, roused while angling five wide entering the stretch, lacked needed late kick. MISS SHELTOWEE urged early, stalked and then loomed at the quarter pole, began to weaken inside the eighth pole. SCARINCI CODE raced up close from the start, traveled along the rail, had no late punch, tired mid stretch. RAMBUNCTIOUS GAL tracked to mid turn, raced five wide on the bend, faded upper stretch. EMILY D. outrun, offered little. K C BARTLEY was a step slow into stride, always outrun.
