**Footnotes**

TRACK RECORD well rated rallied from the far turn angling to mid track inside the eighth pole driving clear in the closing yards. FARMINGTON rated on pace moved between horses on the far turn, leading in the two path upper stretch would cede to outside pressure late. FIDDLERS PRIDE prompted the pace while saving ground would extend into upper stretch weakening there at the rail. SMILE OF SUCCESS slow early stayed back through the far turn, mustered a mild response down the lane gaining in the four path. MASTEROFBALLYDOYLE stalked the pace moving close up through the far turn, would weaken while six wide in upper stretch. BROKE BY NOON stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the far turn, wavered in upper stretch dropping off at mid track. TEXPLOSIVE HALL saved ground staying close for a half then retreated on the far turn. INCREDIBLE SPEED was steadied in close quarters from the seven eighths to the five eighths pole. DAWN'S REVENGE struggled throughout.
