RICH THUNDER dictated the pace from the start, was never seriously threatened, widened leaving the quarter pole, won in hand as much the best. PAPPA SONG settled towards the rear racing mid track, roused mid turn, came five wide into the lane, finished willingly proving second best. ANDRUN tracked racing four to five wide to the far turn, gained mid turn chasing a loose leader, failed to menace needing more in the drive, settled for the show position. MEDUSA rated early and saved ground to mid turn, angled out four wide at the quarter pole, lacked needed surge. RHETORIC tracked down the backside traveling between foes, lacked punch when asked, never threatened. ONE DAY stalked the winner for a half, chased on the turn, faded entering the stretch. UNION EXECUTIVE raced four wide into the first turn, lacked speed, offered little. FALSE HOPE chased the winner to the half, dropped off at the quarter pole, finished spent. AMIGO MIO was always outrun, showed little.
