LADY ON FIRE hustled would wrest the lead setting a relaxed pace to the far turn, shook off EMILY SUE SHINE to take charge in upper stretch winning ridden out. EMILY SUN SHINE stalked the pace chasing LADY ON FIRE through the far turn, clearly no match in upper stretch would hold well as second best. DESIRABLE DESIREE slow early angled six wide in upper stretch mustering enough to best the others. URA WILD WON raced evenly through the far turn then wore down at mid track in upper stretch. DEPENDS ON ANNIE a step slow throughout would labor. SOUTHERN OAKS raced evenly through the backside then flattened out on the far turn. MISSZOEY BELLE struggled throughout.
