Footnotes

RIGHT FLANKER rushed from the gate, vied in a four way battle down the backside, lost the lead to BATON ROUGE at the quarter pole, put to a stiff drive top of the lane, drew clear inside the eighth pole, won comfortably under urging to the wire. BATON ROUGE pressed down the backstretch, dueled around the bend and put a head in front at the quarter pole racing three wide, matched strides with the winner to mid stretch, was outfinished late and just lasted for second place. GAME APPEAL unhurried from the gate, guided to the rail, saved ground to upper stretch, angled to the four path with a furlong to go, surged late just missing second place. IM GOOD AT THAT pressed for the early lead running between foes, dropped off some entering the stretch, tired in the drive besting rest. ROYAL LORD was off slowly and trailed throughout, angled six wide mid stretch, lacked rally never factoring. FLASH JORDAN vied for the early lead racing three wide and between rivals, dropped off leaving the quarter pole, drifted wide in upper stretch giving way.
