STOLEN RUBIES broke alertly setting the pace on soft splits through the far turn, widened the lead along the inside in upper stretch holding while a bit weary late. PRIDE OF PACIFIC unhurried early cut the corner emerging at the rail in upper stretch, angled to the two path gaining steadily on the winner. SWEET JILL stalked close up through the backside, dropped off the leaders on the far turn angling five wide for the stretch run, finished evenly. HARE PRIZE stalked the pace chasing through the far turn, weakened in the three path upper stretch. MAUDIE JO played no factor swinging six wide in upper stretch. OUR CRYSTAL BLUE slow early was never involved. AUNT EMMA raced second flight through the backside folding up on the far turn. RUNFAST chased the pace through the backside then wilted on the far turn.
