JAZZ BEAT settled along the inside advanced on the far turn firing clear in the two path upper stretch holding firm late under a drive. PURE POLISHED lost ground early, gained a threatening position on the far turn, vied willingly down the lane angling from mid track to the four path late. NAKED PASSION stalked close up through the far turn, looming in the two path upper stretch gave even action needing more. LADY LARKSPUR tracked early gaining a striking position on the far turn, extending in the four then three path down the lane gave an even finish. BEHAVE raced evenly off the pace coming four wide to upper stretch, roused hard there lacked late surge. MY PRINCESS hustled clear set the pace through the far turn then gave way along the inside in upper stretch. SWEETANDPERFECT slow early failed to menace racing six wide in upper stretch. BURR HILL GIRL was never involved finishing along the rail. THREEFORKS RIVER a step slow in second flight played no factor racing five wide down the stretch. GOLDILICIOUS hustled along through the backside would give way on the far turn.
