Footnotes

NAE PROBLEM settled early fired into the far turn bidding three deep there, dueled abreast BILL'S THRILL in upper stretch edging clear in the four path. BILL'S THRILL stalked the pace pressing to put a head in front on the far turn, dueled between horses to upper stretch ceding late to outside pressure. TIP ALONG slow early trailed the field through the far turn, showed life a sixteenth out gaining after the fact. POWER GRACE sent clear set the pace through the backside, hooked along the rail on the far turn dueled into upper stretch wearing down there. KIT KATS LUCK tracked evenly through the backside looming a threat as a trio of front runners dueled on the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch weakened under a drive. DANCING TIGER failed to respond finishing near mid track. VERYLITTLEPATIENCE stalked early pressing up to challenge on the backside, wavered into the far turn giving way there.
