**Footnotes**

TUFFY COTTRELL broke alertly but was soon pressured, maintained a slight edge racing two wide, asked for more top of the lane, responded to increase margin, held safe being kept to task. MITCH'S TWO BELOW rated early traveling mid pack, made a bold four wide move at the quarter pole, loomed off the winner mid stretch, was turned away and settled for second best in a game try. HEADLINE settled towards the rear, launched rally swinging five wide upper stretch, closed willingly picking up the show position. VALID RIDE (ARG) well placed running along the rail in the early going, lost position entering the stretch, angled wide at the eighth pole, was under strong left handed stick and surged belatedly finishing with interest. FULL HORSE POWER was urged shortly after the start but failed to respond, raced towards the rear till upper stretch, showed action too late improving placing but never menaced. SNOWBOARD RIDGE raced up close racing three wide around the turn, gave chase running between foes top of the stretch, lacked rally and weakened in the drive. K'S BOYWONDER well placed down the backside, made a menacing move at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and flattened out inside the eighth pole. HIGH ACT pressed the winner to the far turn racing along the rail, began to drop off in upper stretch, used up. EL WINDO was always outrun, swung seven wide top of the lane, offered little. VOSE THE HOST lacked speed racing mid track, dropped off to trail entering the stretch, showed little.
