Footnotes

REAL DANDY taken back from the break, tucked inside moving patiently to the 1/2, circled under prompting outside the 1/4 pole, surged up widest into upper stretch, edged away under stiff right handed urging. MAGNA GRADUATE raced evenly while never far back, saved ground advancing along the inside near the 3/16 pole, surged to even terms locking up with REAL DANDY in deep stretch, gave continued game response while outfinished. ANTHONY J. unhurried off a contested pace, swung to the outside vying 5 wide on the far turn, dueled into upper stretch, lost momentum hanging in the closing yards. SHAMOAN (IRE) sent close up losing ground to the backside, stalked 5 wide into the far turn, gained there putting a head in front at the top of the lane, collared from the outside near the 1/8 pole, wore down under pressure. DOVER DERE broke well to go close up, tracked along the inside to the far turn, bid near the rail outside the 1/4 pole, leveled off in upper stretch. DIAMOND ISLE dropped back off the early pace, varied little through the far turn, gave a mild move as the front end wore down into stretch, weakened under a drive. PINPOINT sent up going wide to the backside, lost ground pressing the issue to the far turn, wilted there giving way into stretch. GOLDEN MAN raced evenly at mid pack, was shuffled back along the inside on the far turn, had no recovery into stretch. DEVILMENT sent to the front end, pressed from between horses to the far turn, extended there, was empty reaching the lane. BERNIE BLUE hustled out pressing the early pace, went in tandem to the far turn, continued to duel in extended fashion to the 1/4 pole, finally wore out at the head of the lane. ABLO sent to the top, pressed along the inside, wavered on the far turn, folded up into lane.
