**Footnotes**

SWHOOPIE broke sharply vying for the lead, was smartly taken back entering the far turn to stalk, rallied three wide top of the lane, drew clear mid stretch under strong handling holding safe to the finish. VINELAND ROAD angled to the rail going into the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch, swung out four wide mounting bid mid stretch, closed willingly. SHERRI SAID settled along the rail in mid pack, swung five wide upper stretch, found best stride late finishing with interest. SECRET REVENGE lacked speed racing in the second flight, rallied between foes in deep stretch, surged belatedly vying for a minor award. HIDDEN QUEENS raced evenly in the second flight, failed to respond on the turn when roused, finally improved in deep stretch but never menaced. MEG OF MY HEART lacked speed racing wide throughout, mildly gained in deep stretch, no real threat. AVALON LIGHT raced up close from the start, bid mid turn taking control at the quarter pole, battled to mid stretch, gave way late. LADY GRIZ sent hard and dueled early on, had the rail entering the stretch, fought hard to the sixteenth pole then gave way. SPICY BOMB raced evenly showing little. DOUBLE DECK was always outrun in a dull performance. THE TRAINER OF SHERRI SAID CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF VINELAND ROAD FOR INTERFERENCE NEAR THE THREE EIGHTHS POLE, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED.
