Footnotes

RIGHT ON QUEUE slow early angled to mid track in upper stretch surging a sixteenth out getting a head up on the wire. FOUR ONE ONE stalked then pressured the pace three deep on the turn, nudged to a narrow lead in upper stretch only to be grabbed from the outside in the last stride. RAKA went evenly early edging closer on the turn, ranged up four deep in upper stretch dueling on even terms to the wire. SNACK DADDY broke alertly engaging WILLIAM PALEY on pace dueling abreast that one through the turn, joined by others down the lane extended between horses in the two path coming up a bit short. RED TWENTY TWO slow early was swung six wide in upper stretch giving an even finish. BENEDICTUS came in bumping then laying on MITCH'S TWO BELOW at the break, stayed back after. WILLIAM PALEY broke sharply joining SNACK DADDY on pace dueling along the rail to upper stretch, extending late had little left. INFIELD'S HALO raced inside playing no factor. MITCH'S TWO BELOW was bumped and herded by BENEDICTUS after the break, labored from there. TWO TIMES GOLD outrun early would tire in the three path.
