NOMADIKAT broke alertly nursing a short lead through the turn, took charge in upper stretch drawing out under a drive in the four and five path. GITANO BOY stalked close up through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch proved no match for the winner salvaging place in the six path. SHORE MANOR pressed then chased along the inside through the turn, extending in the two path down the stretch weakened late. PRESS EM UP struggled well back.
