Footnotes

SCORPIO DOG settled nicely in the second flight racing between rivals on the bend, came three wide into the lane, slowly wore down COUNTRY IN in deep stretch edging clear at the finish. COUNTRY IN pressed the early pace, moved for the lead mid turn racing three wide, drove clear at the quarter pole and angled to the rail top of the lane, could not hold off SCORPIO DOG in last jumps and settled for second best in a hard effort. LINEAR MOTION dueled in a thee way battle going into the far turn racing between foes, began to chase the runner up entering the stretch while angling four wide, loomed to the wire but needed a bit more. GUSKA'S GOLD raced evenly along the rail around the turn, hard ridden from top of the stretch, laced kick besting rest. AUDITORIUM was off a step slow, rushed hard into the far turn, chased at the quarter pole running four to five wide, leveled off in upper stretch. MR NO SOCKS was hard used vying for the early lead, vied in a three way battle to the three eighths pole racing along the rail, steadily faded from upper stretch. GONE PROSPECTING was outrun early, raced well off the rail continuing to drop further off the pace from mid turn, was pulled up in upper stretch and rider dismounted.
