Footnotes

MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION hustled out, pressed for lead through the turn, hooked from the outside by LEGENDARY TRAITORS into lane, dug deep late to prevail. LEGENDARY TRAITORS went evenly, rallied into turn, hooked MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION from the outside near the 1/4 pole, dueled abreast foe through the lane, all out while repelled to wire. BUCCANEER FEVER went evenly, dropped off on turn, 4 wide to lane, outbid rest. EXECUTIVE WILLIE sent hard inside, pressed from rail into lane, weakened in drive. ALL AND ALL slow early, varied little on turn, went evenly lane, no menace. HILL ROAD DANCER hustled out, pressed hard through the turn, wilted top stretch. TULAROSA KID went evenly off the pace, mild move on the turn, weakened lane. BOBS BIG IDEA always outrun. J P PETERSON offered little. STORM DAMAGE stumbled start, struggled.
