**Footnotes**

PART OF THE PLAN raced evenly 4 wide into the turn, moved to FANCY NUMBERS in upper stretch, gave steady surge abreast the pacesetter, arrived in time. FANCY NUMBERS hustled to the top, pressed to a short lead racing on the turn, dug in along the inside, remained responsive, run down in final yards. MS. EXECUTIVE CITY sent hard engaging FANCY NUMBERS on the pace, pursued full out to the 1/4 pole, asked for more in extended mode in upper stretch, wore out fading off late. BABBLE ON hustled with even response in the early going, varied little under continued asking on the turn, had no belated rally finishing a weary fourth. NO MORE TAX was bumped and crowded by SPEEDY KITTY leaving the gate, remained well back to the 1/4 pole, swung 5 wide in upper stretch, had little to offer in drive. CHEMISTRY a step slow at the break, never found stride laboring home. DOEY WILD away slowly, was always outrun finishing 6 wide. IRISH CLASSIC showed some early speed, wavered nearing the 1/4 pole, empty in upper stretch. UPSWING offered little. SPEEDY KITTY unruly loading the gate, veered in jamming NO MORE TAX at the break, struggled throughout.
