**Footnotes**

TRADE SIGNAL away slowly lost ground through the backside moving to bid on the far turn, took aim abreast TWOBITHUSTLER in upper stretch going fully extended to prevail on the wire. TWOBITHUSTLER well rated gave a quick four deep move on the far turn to sweep to the lead, collared along the inside late by TRADE SIGNAL would battle all out ceding grudgingly in the final stride. LEWIE D tracked the early pace edging closer to loom prominently on the far turn, failed to sustain the effort giving even action in drive to hold others. JUST YOU AND I KID sluggish early was never a threat passing tired ones down the lane. MOTHER'S LOVE was always outrun finishing wide. JORDAN AND JUSTIN raced evenly off the pace while never involved. A DEVIL OF A TRIP stalked then pressed MY SECRET SERVICE on pace grabbing a short lead near the half working the margin into the far turn, collared there would wear to pressure giving way in upper stretch. COAST COMMANDER stalked the early pace while saving ground, wilted on the far turn. MY SECRET SERVICE prompted the pace for half a mile then folded up on the far turn. ANOTHER DEVIL well back throughout took a bad step leaving the far turn losing the rider, was vanned off after the race.
