SUSIE'S SURPRISE unhurried early fired leaving the far turn, bid four deep upper stretch edging clear driving. INSIDE THE PEARL raced evenly through the backside picking it up on the far turn, bid between horses in the three path upper stretch ceding late to outside pressure. JAZZY GIRL sent clear set a soft pace through the far turn, hooked along the rail in upper stretch would wear down. LEXI TAP bumped at the break gave a prompted middle move pressing to even terms between horses in the two path upper stretch, extending the final eighth would tire late. BARREL OF FUN played no factor finishing near mid track. DAD'S GIRL slow early raced in close quarters near the five eighths pole, would fold up on the far turn. LITTLEWAN offered little racing six wide down the stretch. SPLENDID AGAIN gave steady retreat.
