Footnotes

SPA PRINCESS sent hard grabbed the early lead hustling through the turn, digging in from the two path held firm the final eighth. INDIAN FOOTSTEPS stalked along the inside through the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch extended to salvage place. SILVER VOW gave hard pursuit through the turn angling five wide in upper stretch, extending at mid track would weaken late. WALTZING TIME a step slow through the turn gave a mild move in upper stretch finishing evenly in the four path. LALIQUE slow early saved ground to upper stretch gaining then holding position. CLASSIC CHANT raced evenly through the turn then weakened in the six path upper stretch. SEAHAG chased early then wavered on the turn fading into upper stretch. LEADER OF THE LITE was always outrun racing eight wide through the lane.
