SOCIETY DAME well placed, moved to leaders, went clear along the inside. TRUE GLITTER unhurried, began move into lane, surged steadily to wire. NAUTICAL NELLIE well back, varied little to 1/2, angled out, came on too late. TURN A PROFITT hustled to front, pressed on pace, extended to lane, weakened. NUTBUSH went evenly, lacked late response. NURSE SHARON laid close up, loomed backside, wore down. NATRONA slow early, no factor. TEA SIPPER rushed inside, chased to 1/2, folded. WIDER SMILE away alertly, set pace, tired. READ THE CARDS always outrun.
