Footnotes

TORDUE sent hard from the gate, duelled on the inside of FEED FOR SPEED to the 1/4 pole, shook off that one and went clear upper stretch, kept to a drive off the inside and held safe. DOUBTFUL DIVA stalked the early pace, pursued evenly on the turn, came with a late inside surge to bid boldly. LEOPARD LADY slow early, remained outrun on the turn, set down 6 wide stretch, responded with a belated surge. CHECKER SUE ducked out leaving the gate, hustled close up, raced 5 wide into the stretch, hung deep stretch. GREE LEE DEE outrun early, angled to rail, gave a mild move upper stretch, bogged down late. FUHR ELISE a step slow early, was never involved. PROUD TEARS dropped back, lost ground to stretch, proved no factor. FEED FOR SPEED broke sharply, pressed abreast TORDUE through the turn, leg weary upper stretch, gave way. IN MILLIE'S HONOR struggled well back throughout.
