Footnotes

LEADING ON unhurried early saved ground cutting the corner to contention in upper stretch, took aim at DE BRANDON BOY surging up gamely on the rail. DE BRANDON BOY moved on pace matching strides with GENERALISSIMO through the far turn, shook off that one only to collared from the inside by LEADING ON a sixteenth out, went fully extended ceding the issue in the last strides. AMBER DUBAI raced evenly edging close on the backside, angled out six wide in upper stretch gave willing late response. MOON IS A STAR slow early found stride during the drive, looking for room on the inside had good late action. PRINCE OF SALT LAKE raced second flight giving a mild rally into upper stretch, responded evenly along the inside in drive. GLITTERESSENCE stalked the pace vying hard through the far turn, came up short at mid track down the lane. GENERALISSIMO away alertly pressured the pace racing abreast DE BRANDON BOY through the far turn, was used up at the head of the stretch. A KING'S SMILE was always outrun. AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT tracked evenly through the far turn then flattened out in upper stretch. NORTHTOBAGHDAD was always outrun.
