Footnotes

ATLANTIC RIDER stalked along the rail to top of the lane, angled out three wide splitting foes at the sixteenth pole, surged clear nearing the wire. TEVEZ unhurried early racing mid track, swung seven wide upper stretch, flashed late abreast rivals at the finish to get the bob for second place. BE BOPPIN WYNN well placed early, bid four wide to a menacing position mid stretch, was outgamed nearing the wire needing a bit more. FORSTER HALL sent and pressed for the lead form the start, gained a slight edge mid stretch, tired late being unfinished for a minor award. TRISKIN set a pressured pace throughout, fought hard to deep stretch, faded in last strides. BOOMERANG STAR lacked speed racing towards the rear, came six wide upper stretch under a stiff drive, failed to menace. PUT HIM BACK raced evenly along the rail throughout, failed to respond when asked, no threat. AMBER DUBAI was always outrun, showed little. LEGACY HUNTER raced mid pack traveling between foes on the bend, gave way mid stretch.
