Footnotes

SPANISH AFFAIR stalked early then ranged up four wide on the turn dueling on the inside shoulder of ANOTHER OREO to upper stretch, moving in tandem would dig deep late to edge clear. ANOTHER OREO was hustled on the outside drawing to even terms five wide on the turn, dueled abreast SPANISH AFFAIR through the stretch giving all to no avail. LUXURY TAX bobbed at the break rushing up to join the pace, pressed between horses in the three path through the turn, dropped off the top pair in upper stretch finding enough to hold off the others. LIL GREAT TOUCH slow early was angled four wide in upper stretch mustering a mild response to gain position late. KID KLARE sent inside pressed the pace along the rail to upper stretch, wavered there dropping back. LITTLE BOPPER slow early played no factor. VISION WITHINREACH broke sharply engaging the pace pressing from between horses in the two path on the turn, would wilt in upper stretch. DANIEL FARADAY gave way on the turn bearing out badly to upper stretch, was eased to the wire. STARCASM struggling well back was eased in the stretch.
