FINAL FITZ slow early advanced out of the turn looming abreast the pacesetter in upper stretch, hooked foe inside the eighth pole drawing out under a drive. GRANDESTROYALE set the pace widening the edge on the turn, digging in from the two path was hooked from the outside proving no match late. SARAVA RULES slow early came six wide in upper stretch gaining belatedly with even action. GET THERE raced evenly along the inside, roused in upper stretch lacked needed surge. D'WILDGOLD away slowly stayed back on the turn, mustered a mild response passing tired ones down the lane. O B THE BEST chased the pace through the turn then wore down in upper stretch. BAD POWER was always a step slow. KILLIAN'S ADVICE was always outrun. STAR RATING showed early speed then gave way from the quarter pole.
