Footnotes

BEA'S TREASURE stalked traveling off the rail around the bend, launched rally coming four wide into the lane, drew even in upper stretch, began to draw off inside the eighth pole receiving strong left handed stick. SMOOTH TRANSITION settled towards the rear and running mid track, swung widest racing five wide into the lane, gave chase under a stiff drive, finished willing gaining second place late. HIGHER PLACE was brushed by WINNING WORTH at the break, rushed leaving the far turn, vied in a three way battle entering the stretch racing between rivals, could not keep pace in the final furlong, tired late losing second place. GREAT CAUSE raced up close saving ground throughout, remained a threat to upper stretch, began to tire mid stretch. WINNING WORTH broke a bit in brushing HIGHER PLACE leaving the gate, quickly sent up to take the lead, angled a bit towards the rail, headed past the quarter pole, was all done giving way mid stretch, used up. HE'S A DIXIE BOY was always outrun, broke down leaving the far turn and lost the rider.
