BROTHER KEITH stalked close up through the turn, bid three deep in upper stretch locking up abreast CALL THE GUY late needing all to prevail. CALL THE GUY hustled out worked the pace keeping a head in front through the turn, extending inside of rivals from three path down the lane battled BROTHER KEITH step for step to the wire. GENERAL STAFF broke sharply pressuring CALL THE GUY on pace through the turn, extending between horses in upper stretch came up a bit short late. SHARP PICK slow early angled six wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. MR. BALLISTIC a step slow early played no factor. DARCY BOY slow early was never involved.
