NOBLE GEST hustled leaving the gate, matched strides with SOMETHINGABOUTMARY to the eighth pole, shook clear and drew off for a convincing victory being ridden out. SOMETHINGABOUTMARY hard used early, matched strides wit the winner to mid stretch running along the rail, could not keep pace inside the eighth pole, just held on saving second place being fully extended. CITY TAPPER settled early, roused mid turn, came five wide looming off duelers in upper stretch, was no match for the winner but continued on willingly just missing second place. POKER GIRL well placed stalking top pair around the bend, bid four wide and vied upper stretch, leveled off late besting rest. NOTABLY MADE unhurried in the early going, put to a stiff drive leaving the quarter pole, came four wide entering the stretch, did show belated interest but was no real threat. RUMMY'S ACE saved ground throughout, angled a bit top of the stretch, failed to respond. JASMINE STORM was off late trailing throughout, raced along the rail into the lane, passed two weary rivals, never factored. SWEET CAMELARA never factored racing mid track. KINGSFORD JOY held good early position tracking the pacesetters, began to fade leaving the quarter pole, drifted out seven wide upper stretch, stopped mid stretch and was eased across the finish line.
