OUT OF INK vied for the lead racing between foes at the half, cleared on the bend, headed by WAY OF AN EAGLE in mid stretch, dug in under a stiff drive while matching strides, prevailed in a very determined effort. WAY OF AN EAGLE nicely rated, sat patient to mid turn, angled wide leaving the quarter pole, collared OUT OF INK mid stretch, went head to head to the finish, lost head bob on the wire, proved a game second best. LIVELY EXIT unhurried and raced in the second flight, rallied five wide upper stretch, finished willingly besting rest. MUSICAL MONEY raced a little off the rail going down the backside, put to a stiff drive running towards the inside from top of the stretch, failed to menace. ISNT HE rushed down the backstretch, vied in three way duel at the half, began to fade in upper stretch, all done at the eighth pole. ROVE was squeezed at the start, was outrun throughout, never involved. DOCTOR BOROS raced four wide mid way on the first turn going up for the lead when MEDIA STORM was being pulled while in distress, held a slight edge running towards the inside going down the backstretch, vied in three way battle at the half, was all done leaving the quarter pole, finished well beaten. MEDIA STORM held the lead going into the first turn, took a bad step and was moved out wide starting down the backside, was pulled up and vanned off.
