JAZZ COURT moved to the front going into the first turn, set a well rated pace traveling off the rail, challenged mid turn by a pair of rivals, responded to urging repulsing those threats by upper stretch, widened from mid stretch being ridden out as much the best. PARADISE PRINCE settled in the second flight, rallied along the rail near the quarter pole, chased loose winner from upper stretch, never menaced but won the battle for second place in a willing effort. R. J. SAYS raced four wide into the first turn, tracked to the far turn, made a bold three wide run mid turn to loom off the winner at the quarter pole, was turned away and outfinished late vying for second place. STORMY PUDDLES stalked early on, bid in tandem leaving the far turn, chased at the quarter pole traveling between foes, weakened from mid stretch. STEEL THE REWARD trailed to the half, improved near the quarter pole, angled out five wide mid stretch under a drive, lacked needed surge. AFFAIR INTHE WOODS stalked the winner for the opening half mile, began to fade at the quarter pole, drifted wide giving way in the stretch. PADDY TAP raced evenly in the second flight, saved ground to no avail, showed little. SWARR varied little racing towards the rear, finished well beaten showing little. ONE HUNDRED LAUGHS flashed brief foot, was all done leaving the far turn, stopped entering the stretch and was eased across the finish line. HOT AIR struggled early, lost contact with the field leaving the far turn and was eased.
