VENTURE CAPITAL sent hard leaving the gate and was pressured throughout, dug in from mid stretch under an all out drive, just held on being fully extended. DISCO INDY stalked the winner early on, bid four wide at the quarter pole almost drawing even, surged in tandem coming to the wire, was out nodded by the winner but got the place position by a very narrow margin in a hard effort. CAPE HATCHET settled in the second flight, lacked response till upper stretch, took up slightly getting around a tiring FIRE CHIEF at the eighth pole, ducked to the rail under an all out drive, surged strongly in last jumps missing in a game effort. RADICAL FRINGE tracked a hot pace, bid five wide top of the stretch, loomed off duelers inside the furlong marker, was outgamed in final strides. SOVEREIGN ROAD trailed to mid stretch, was hard ridden coming six wide late, gave belated action but was no real threat. GRAND CAPTAIN lacked speed, swung five wide entering the stretch, needed more, never menaced. FIRE CHIEF sent hard pressing the winner to mid turn, began to drop off top of the stretch, no late factor. LAZY NATHAN showed brief foot, saved ground around the bend, faded in the lane.
