BROKEN APPLE stalked early firing from the quarter pole to grab a short lead leaving the turn, widened outside the eighth pole then held SALZBURG SLEW at bay late. SALZBURG SLEW settled early gave a prompted move on the turn looming off BROKEN APPLE in upper stretch, given a tap inside the eighth pole went hand ridden the final sixteenth vying willingly to wire. SNACK DADDY hustled out pressured the pace ceding to BROKEN APPLE on the turn, extended under a drive came up a bit short. SANTOS POINT slow early was angled to the four path in upper stretch showing belated interest. AVELINA'S TICKET varied little throughout playing no factor. LOCKE THE DOC flashed early speed then gave way on the turn. TIGER WILL had early speed then abruptly retreated on the turn. JEMARU dropped far back early.
