Footnotes

ALLSAROTT moved off the rail entering the backside to stalk, moved up at the half vying for the lead, took a slight lead at the quarter pole, dug in late holding firm under strong handling. I AM THE KING broke well and then was taken back to rate running along the rail, sat patient to top of the lane, set down and closed willingly in deep stretch getting the nod for second place. AL BASHA unhurried and lagged behind to top of the stretch, gained momentum while angling six wide for the stretch drive, closed fast but was out noddied vying for second place. WATCHINGIRLSGOBY hustled to the front, set a pressured pace, fought hard to top of the stretch, weakened late from earlier efforts. GUARDIANOFTHENORTH well placed racing up close to the pace, bid three wide entering the stretch looming off the winner, flattened out needing more late. RAILROAD tracked down the backside running four wide to the half, failed to respond when roused, lacked needed surge. UNBRIDLED WISDOM raced three wide to the half, chased under urging mid turn, failed to menace and tired in the drive.
