CITY CODE away alertly pressed on a short lead through the turn, cut loose in upper stretch responded widening under a drive. BLUE RODEO was hustled out pressing then chasing to upper stretch, no match from the eighth pole held up for place. MANHASSET INDIAN bobbled at the break, was rushed along to upper stretch, went evenly there to hold others. YOYO JABO was in tight at the break, labored to upper stretch, gave a modest response to pass tired ones there. KING STEVEN in tight at the break raced evenly gaining mild position. AL'S CROW went evenly at mid pack failing to mount a bid. SWIPER THE FOX played no factor. QUICK TRICK dropped off on the turn. SAY YES DEAR was hustled along, chased through the turn then wore out. KARAKORUM KEEPSAKE showed poor form and was eased on the turn.
