MASTER SPEAK broke alertly setting the pace traveling comfortably through the turn, widened the edge in upper stretch holding sway under a drive in the three path. MIDNIGHT THUNDER slow early rallied to contention in upper stretch, extending in the two path responded willingly late. FARLEYSHELONWHEELS away slowly stayed back through the turn, came six wide in upper stretch closing in gamely late. FIRE RIDGE laid close up chasing through the turn, all out in the four path upper stretch would wear down. CHALLENGER a step slow through the turn moved up at bit at mid track in upper stretch then hung the final eighth. READY TO POUNCE gave hard pursuit through the turn then wore out at mid track in upper stretch. LIFE GUARD was always outrun. SMOOTH TOWN showed early speed then wavered on the turn giving way to upper stretch. BAI BAI DUBAI struggled throughout.
