Footnotes

SECRET FEVER was patiently ridden in the early stages, launched bid near the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch, surged strongly in deep stretch, cleared late under strong handling. MR. REGENT rushed from the gate, set a pressured pace down the backside, held INFINITE GLORY safe in the drive but could not contain a fast closing SECRET FEVER coming to the wire, settled for second best in a very hard effort. INFINITE GLORY raced up close to the pace from the start, almost drew even with MR. REGENT in upper stretch, could not get by and leveled off late proving third best. RAYWICK tracked throughout, set down coming five wide into the lane, finished in willing manner needing a bit more late. DOC'S OPTION raced wide going down the backside, failed to menace. BARAK was a step slow leaving the gate, offered little. MAJESTIC KARAKORUM hustled from the gate, pressed the runner up down the backstretch, started to drop off entering the stretch, no late factor. MOMO MONEY lacked speed and raced wide throughout, showed little.
