Footnotes

KOKOMO GYPSY tracked the pace racing five wide through the backside, drew even on the far turn, dueled abreast rival down the stretch extending up in the four path. KELLHAM stalked close up through the backside, pressed to a short lead on the far turn, dueled along the inside down the stretch ceding grudgingly in the two path. ZEPHYR LIGHT unhurried early stayed back through the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch gained then held position. ROAR TIGER ROAR off slowly came five wide upper stretch, finished evenly near mid track. DEVIL BY SANDY sent clear set the pace, hooked into the far turn would wear down from the three eighths pole. BLUE SOLDIER squeezed back at the break played no factor. LIES AND AFFAIRS stalked evenly through the far turn then wilted in upper stretch. ADVISE AND CONSENT remained sluggish throughout. HARMONIC MAN gave way after a half mile.
