LOS BOMBEROS broke alertly taking immediate control, set the pace traveling two to three wide, opened up entering the stretch, won easily being ridden out. GO YANKEES chased the winner around the bend, never threatened in the lane and dug in late under pressure saving second place. TRIPPIN' AWAY settled in mid pack, bid four wide mid stretch, surged nearing the wire just missing second place in a good effort. FIRE CHIEF angled to the rail shortly after the start, saved ground around the bend, lacked needed late punch besting rest. WONDER WAY settled in the second flight along the rail, angled out under a drive upper stretch, improved placing but never threatened. FASTER THAN FLASH raced along the rail towards the rear, angled in mid stretch, mildly bid was no factor. BELIEVE DAT tracked around the turn racing in the four path, moved out six wide mid stretch, failed to respond. PRONTO CABALLO stalked to the quarter pole traveling three wide, began to fade mid stretch, used up. MILWAUKEE CHIEF was always outrun, dull effort. BYESVILLE was outrun racing wide throughout, offered little.
