MIDNIGHT LEGACY well rated advanced from the half mile pole taking the lead into the far turn, angled toward mid track drew out in upper stretch holding firm the final eighth. LIGHTNINGFASTMAN away slowly stayed back to the half, began to respond on the far turn angling to the four path in upper stretch finishing fast to salvage place. WATCH ROCK crowded at the break settled in off the pace, fired on the far turn chasing a loose MIDNIGHT LEGACY from mid track in upper stretch, extending the final eighth would hang late. BELLAMY FLYER in close at the break was unhurried early, roused to bid gained on the far turn circling out in upper stretch, lost momentum in the six path down the lane finishing evenly. BLUE SOLDIER raced evenly in mid pack drawing closer as the field bunched on the far turn, came three path in upper stretch lacking needed late surge. SICCARDI failed to respond. MALIBU MYSTERY in close at the break was always outrun. RICHIE'S REAL DEAL prompted the pace chasing through the far turn, wilted abruptly in upper stretch fading on the rail. LEDGEHILL veered out rushing at the break, pressured the pace through the backside chasing on the far turn, would give way abruptly in upper stretch.
