ARGUE THE TOSS stalked the pace through the far turn, extending in the three path from the eighth pole wrested a late lead holding off POGO STICK PATTY at the end. POGO STICK PATTY was squeezed by LA PRESTIGE and forced to steady after the break, well back to the half began to move on the far turn, vied four deep mid stretch pressing hard to the wire. SILVER MADISON stalked the pace rallying to clear on the far turn, digging in from the two path down the lane would cede when weary to outside pressure. LA PRESTIGE bore out jamming rivals at the break, chased the pace through the far turn then weakened in the four path upper stretch. START THE BAND set a soft pace through the backside, ceded on the far turn tiring along the rail in upper stretch. FIVE O'CLOCK TESSI threw head as the gate opened, hustled along through the backside would tired on the far turn. BLINDLOVE raced second flight tiring on the far turn. PARDON THIS KISS was in tight steadying after the break, played no factor. MY JULIE'S WITT was eased in upper stretch joggng to the wire. SPLINK bumped at the break was done after a half mile walking to the wire form the eighth pole.
