Footnotes

BOO DUTTON hustled to the top, set a well rated pace traveling along the inside, asked for more leaving the quarter pole, responded to widen on the field upper stretch, won easily being ridden out. ANARCHY rated traveling mid pack, angled to the rail at the quarter pole, cut the corner top of the stretch, chased the winner from upper stretch, never threatened proving second best. THISSKYSABEAUTY tracked racing a little off the rail, bid three wide upper stretch, battled for a minor award from mid stretch, edged up late securing the show position. R. CAMPFIRE broke well stalking the winner from the start, gave chase from mid turn, lacked rally and was edged out of third place in last jumps. REGAL QUEST stalked down the backside, raced between rivals mid turn, swung out six wide upper stretch, tired in the drive besting rest. D'WILDGOLD raced towards the rear throughout saving ground, asked mid turn, lacked serious bid never factoring. ETHICAL LAWYER settled in the second flight at mid track, failed to menace. COUNTRY MUSIC BOY lacked speed trailing down the backstretch, angled out five to six wide upper, showed little. NAIF tracked to the far turn racing off the rail, was all done leaving the quarter dropping off to last in mid stretch.
