Footnotes

SPYGLASS pressed a short lead early shaking clear on the turn, widened the edge in upper stretch, holding up late in the two path. BEA'S TREASURE pressed early then dropped off the leaders on the turn, loomed three wide in upper stretch closing the gap late. HONEST EXPECTATION chased early inside dropping off the leaders on the turn, saved ground to upper stretch bidding evenly late in the two path. YOU'RE MY BOY BLUE slow early angled five wide in upper stretch finishing evenly near mid track. SWAP UP a step slow through the turn raced four path down the lane proving no menace. WON WILD DUDE pressured the pace through the turn then tired in the three path upper stretch. CASTLEPOST raced a step slow from the outset fading at mid track in upper stretch. SIR SILVER FOX was always outrun. IMPERIAL PRIDE fractious in the starting gate was slow early playing no factor. DADDY J U flashed early speed then gave way on the turn easing to the wire.
