Footnotes

YANKEE VICE unhurried from the gate, settled well off the pace, lagged to the far turn, quickly gained near the quarter pole, split foes entering the stretch, angled out mid stretch, collared TIGHTH WAGER from the outside, edged clear under steady handling. TIGHT WAGER nicely rated, sat patient to mid turn, rallied five wide to vie for command at the quarter pole, held a slight lead upper stretch, dueled racing between foes inside the eighth pole, failed to hold off YANKEE VICE coming to the finish, proved a game second best. DANCIN' DENNIS well placed early, dueled for the lead racing between rivals at the half, continued on gamely to vie throughout the stretch run, was out finished deep stretch, hard effort. CAST NO SHADOW rated from the start, traveled six wide for the run down the backside, asked mid turn, did improve placing but was no threat. GRAND VIEW CLIFFS rated from the start. moved out to mid track as the field entered the backside, rushed bid near the half, vied between rivals at the three eighths, was under an all out drive top of the lane, flattened out, never threatened in the drive. FREE CLEARANCE sent hard, dueled to the half, had little left after six furlongs, gave way upper stretch. SIR GULCH rushed from the gate, vied for the lead for the opening half, faded mid turn, gave way at the quarter pole, used up.
