ALEDO SPLASH sat close stalking a brisk pace off the inside to the half, fired on the far turn to move past weakening leaders in upper stretch, ducked out sharply despite brisk right handed urging inside the eighth pole, straightened quickly holding firm on the outside. SABINCIELO dropped back early laboring through the far turn, swung out into upper stretch coming on eight wide to grab place in the final yards. QUICK TREND sent up early pressing CITY BOY to the backside, ceded to rival angling wider near the three eighths pole closing in to duel on the far turn, overpowered by ALEDO SPLASH at the head of the lane chased rival becoming leg weary late. UNSUNG ANGELS well placed early was content to follow a brisk pace through the backside, roused on the far turn mounted a limited bid along the inside, quickly bogged down in upper stretch. UNBRIDLED CAT was never involved. CITY BOY hustled out for the early lead worked the pace racing well off the inside, collared near the quarter pole would fold up under the pressure. COMPUTER GATE hustled along pursuing a quick early pace, was spent after a half mile. RAYWICK dropped well back early laboring throughout.
