Footnotes

DIXIE MOON laid close up following GLITTERESSENCE to the far turn, fired in upper stretch to wrest a clear lead late then dug in holding off CONTROL THE DEVIL in the final yards. CONTROL THE DEVIL raced evenly angling out under prompting on the far turn, put to a stiff drive near mid track found best stride in the final yards arriving too late. UNBRIDLED REBEL stalked early edging to bid off the inside in upper stretch, threatening late would lack needed surge. GLITTERESSENCE ducked out leaving the gate was rushed hard to grab the early lead, worked the pace into upper stretch then lugged in when weary an eighth out impeding MOON IS A STAR in the process, had little left late. AL FAASIL slow early mustered a modest rally through the lane. MOON IS A STAR rated off a hurried pace saved ground vying hard out of the far turn, was squeezed at the rail twice by GLITTERESSENCE checking in upper stretch then again near the finish. A KING'S SMILE played no factor. SPEEDSPOTS was always outrun bearing out badly into upper stretch. SEFAPIANOS HOME labored well back. A stewards inquiry into the stretch run resulted in no changes.
