WISH UPON THE MOON broke alertly and was angled towards the rail going down the backside, headed by GO R V GO at the five eighths pole, kept that rival pinned along the rail throughout, maintained slim advantage around the bend, dug in under strong handling from mid stretch holding safe to the finish. BENNY HALL unhurried early running along the rail, rallied mid turn improving placing, cut the corner entering the stretch, angled out deep stretch to close willingly grabbing the place position in willing effort. GO R V GO rushed shortly after the start, had to briefly steady near the five eighths pole when WISH UPON THE MOON angled towards the rail, vied with that rival running in close quarters to deep stretch, was outfinished late and just lost second place in last strides, hard try. THE RIDER OF GO RV GO CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF WISH UPON THE MOON FOR INTERFERENCE GOING DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED. CHAMPION FORM raced up close in the early stages, failed to kick in when roused leaving the quarter pole, never menaced in the drive while besting rest. RULER BOY rated early, made a mild bid running four to five wide at the quarter pole, leveled off upper stretch needing more. CAVALLI raced evenly throughout traveling between foes, lacked response, never threatened. DAPPER DON lacked speed, angled out five wide upper stretch, failed to menace. LOCKE THE DOC flashed brief foot, angled to the rail past the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. HIGHLAND MIST varied little running mid track, gave way entering the stretch, no factor.
