Footnotes

SHOW ME THE CASH sent clear set the pace widening the lead on the turn, angled toward mid track in upper stretch holding firm under a drive. ROCKET RICHIE went evenly in mid pack through the turn, set down at mid track rallied up for place. VALID RIDE (ARG) sent hard chased the pace through the turn, extended in upper stretch angled in to the two path coming up short late. AMENHOTEP bobbled at the break, stayed back through the turn swinging seven wide in upper stretch responding to finish well. KEEN CASE slow early was never involved being taken eight wide in upper stretch. BAMBOO GAP chased early then weakened on the turn. BUDDY'S SONG raced mid pack wearing down in upper stretch. ALL THE GLORY reluctant to load would labor at the back. SO SERENE hustled out pursued through the turn then folded in the six path upper stretch.
